Special Session City Council Meeting Minutes – August 14, 2018 at 6:00 p.m.

I. The City Council met in Regular Session with **Mayor Andrew Garza** calling the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

II. **Roll Call by City Secretary Maria Hernandez.**

IV. **Maria Hernandez** led the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States Flag.

BUSINESS:

1. **Applicants for Police Chief will be interviewed by the City Council in a question and answer format conducted in an Open Session. Each applicant will end their interview by briefly addressing the citizens of George West. (There will be no public participation.)**

Ms. Tammy L. Burr gave a brief, detailed description of her work and education after high school and military. She has law enforcement and administrative experience. She spent 33 years as a law enforcement officer in San Antonio and promoted within the ranks of the Bexar county Sheriff's Department to Captain. She spent 4 years in the position of Deputy Chief before retiring in 2016. Currently she is an administrator with the Alamo Area Council of Governments over training.

The City Council members asked Ms. Tammy L. Burr a series of questions and Mayor Garza asked his questions at the end of the interview.
